We are looking forward to assisting you and will make every reasonable effort to address your needs. So that you may be fully informed about our testing and evaluation services, please read the following. Please do not hesitate to ask any questions if any of the following seems unclear. If at any time, you believe that the services are not meeting your needs, please discuss this immediately with the doctor in charge of your services.

Please be advised that you have requested services directly from the Cambridge School and that the Cambridge School has contracted with RSM Psychology Center, LLC to provide these services for the School on-site. Thus, RSM Psychology Center is an independent contractor for the Cambridge School and the School has the authority over the test results. Your payment for these services will be made directly to the Cambridge School and is your responsibility. These services may or may not be covered by your insurance if you choose to submit your paid receipt or invoice to your insurance company.

Please be aware that we will safeguard your right to confidentiality as it is protected by law. The Cambridge School will be responsible for the safekeeping of any records, data, information, and reports associated with or generated by these services and will have access to all the aforementioned. You will be provided a copy of any report that is generated. Please understand that any requests you may have for records in the future must be made directly to the Cambridge School (not to RSM Psychology Center) and that there may be a charge for such records. The Cambridge School will be responsible for releasing any records to you or others with proper written consent and request from you. Once the evaluation/testing/services are completed, please direct any communications and questions to the Cambridge School.

There are exceptions to the confidentiality or privacy of these services. There may be situations in which your confidentiality may be limited by law, such as in certain legal and court proceedings, insurance cases, claims of disability, threats of harm to self or others, or a suspicion of abuse. We would also have to release this information if a court orders us to do so. If any such situations arise, we will discuss this with you. Also, if you are currently involved (or believe you will be involved) in any legal case, where physical or mental health is at issue, please let us know immediately as our role is **not to serve as expert witnesses. Please understand that we will resist serving as an independent expert witness, and as such, will not act to provide child custody/visitation, divorce, capacity, fitness, or injury opinions.**

Please be advised that testing/evaluations usually begin with an interview/exam, followed by testing and typically a follow up feedback session during which results, diagnoses, and recommendations are discussed. We will also want to review any pertinent educational, medical, and/or mental/health records.

If at any time you have a mental health or medical emergency, please contact your nearest hospital, emergency room or call 911.
